Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 (1) (a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners Temporary Release Act, 1988 for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents No.2 to 4 to release the petitioner on emergency parole for 21 days for operation and bypass surgery of his father, which is scheduled to be held on January 13, 2016 at PGIMS, Chandigarh.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4, only at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case representation dated December 17, 2015 (Annexure P-1) moved by petitioner is dealt with and dispose of within a stipulated period.

5. Accordingly, Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala to dispose of the representation dated December 17, 2015 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner in accordance with law within a week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
