No one is present on behalf of the petitioner.

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to release the detenues, namely, Shakuntala, Anuj, Puja, Soni and Ajay, as referred in para No.3 of the petition, who have illegally been detained by respondents No.4 to 6.

Pursuant to notice of motion issued by this Court, learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Ashok Sangwan, IAS, District Magistrate, Ambala, which is taken on record. As per said reply, none of the alleged detainee was found detained by respondents No.4

to 6. To this effect, statement of brick kiln owner and the other labourers working on the said brick kiln have separately been recorded and translated copies thereof have been annexed with the reply.

Taking into consideration the fact that a team headed by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Barara has visited the spot and has not found any of the alleged detainee on the brick kiln, the present petition is liable to be dismissed being totally misconceived.

Dismissed as such.
