The present petition was filed challenging the order dated 31.03.2010, whereby the prayer made by the petitioner for awarding him with Shaurya Chakra award was rejected. The petition was filed in August 2012.

On 13.05.2014, this Court passed the following order:-

“ Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 has informed the Court that a sub-committee has been constituted, as per the directions of this Court order dated 03.10.2013 and the case of the petitioner is time barred.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to place better affidavit giving details of the persons who

have been awarded Shaurya Chakar who had made their application to the Punjab Government beyond the period of 02 years.

List on 19.09.2014.”

When the order dated 13.05.2014 was not complied with, order dated 10.03.2015 was passed, which reads as under:-

“ Counsel for the petitioner prays for and is granted last opportunity to comply with the order dated 13.05.2014 passed by this Court according to which the petitioner was to place on record the affidavit giving details of persons who have been awarded Shaurya Chakar and had made their application to the Punjab Government beyond the period of 02 years.

Adjourned to 03.08.2015.

Needful be done within a period of eight weeks from today.”.

Till date there is no compliance.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one for the same relief.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file fresh one, in accordance with law.
