RAJAN GUPTA, J.

This is a petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India praying for release of alleged detainee namely Anjali Rana from the custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Dalip Kumar, Assistant Commissioner of Police Head quarter, Panchkula. According to him, statement of alleged detainee namely Anjali Rana has been recorded. Relevant para of the affidavit reads as under :-

"3. That it is further submitted that the statement of detinue namely Anjali Rana was also recorded on dated 03.02.2016. She has stated in her statement that she knows the petitioner from last one year and six months. Petitioner wants to dishonor to her family and makes pressure upon her. Due to pressure I have married with petitioner but I don't accept this marriage because petitioner has pressurized to me. Now I am residing with my parents with my own wish. She has further stated that there is no fear/threat to me from my family. She has further stated that she don't want to go with the petitioner and further wants no relation. Statement has given without any pressure."

According to learned State counsel, Anjali Rana is not in illegal detention.

In view of above, no cause of action survives in this petition.
