Heard learned counsel for the rival parties and perused the last order dated 26.07.2016 made by this Court.

Accordingly, girl-detenuue namely Ishrat has been produced before this Court.

Reply by way of affidavit of Aman Yadav, HPS, ACP, City Ballabgarh filed by learned State counsel today in Court, is taken on record. I have perused the said affidavit. It is stated there in that the age of the girl as per Aadhar Card is 21 years.

As against that, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the girl is minor. In the affidavit, it is stated that according to the School Leaving Certificate, she appears to be minor.

However, I find that there is Aadhar Card and date of birth is given on it, according to which, she is major. At this stage, it is a

disputed question of fact.

In that view of the matter, this petition is disposed of. The girl is found to be major as per Aadhar Card and she is free to live with whom she wants to.

None of the observations made herein above, shall come in the way of either the parties in any other proceedings.
