As per the averments made in the complaint moved by Davinder Kaur, petitioner, her son Jaskaran Jeet Singh was taken away by some unidentified police employees in civil dress without any reason and thus, she apprehended that he might be implicated in some false case.

On notice of motion having been issued, learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Satpal Singh, PPS, D.S.P. Investigation, District Tarn Taran in Court, which is taken on record.

On the strength of the aforesaid affidavit, learned State counsel says that the petitioner had moved the present petition on 14.7.2016 i.e. after the arrest of her son Jaskaran Jit Singh @ Rinku. He was arrested in FIR No.25 dated 13.7.2016 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act registered at P.S. Srai Amant Khan, District Tarn Taran on account of

recovery of 100 gms of heroin, though as of now, he has been released on bail by the trial Court.

In view of the aforesaid, no action is called for in the present petition.
