CRM-W-217-2016 and CRM-W-218-2016 are allowed for
the reasons set out therein.

Of course, learned DAG stoutly opposed the application seeking parole on the ground that applicant-appellant No.1 Chetan Kumar is a hardcore criminal as per the record maintained by the Jail Authorities.

In the face of the above objection made by learned DAG, Haryana, we find that there is no ground for granting parole to the petitioners. As the petitioners have proposed to attend the Kirya ceremony of their father, we are pleased to permit them in police escort to go to the place where the kirya ceremony of their father is to be performed. It is also brought to our notice that two other brothers of petitioner namely Manmohan and Pawan were already granted parole.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, the Superintendent of Central Jail, Hisar is directed to make arrangements for the transportation of these petitioners namely Chetan Kumar and Shalender with police escort to the place where the kirya ceremony of their father is to be performed on 13.08.2016 at 10.00 a.m. He shall also make arrangements for taking them back with police escort to the Central
