This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for granting parole of four weeks to the petitioner to attend the marriage of his sister scheduled to be held on 17.08.2016.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the factum of marriage of sister of the petitioner fixed for 17.08.2016 is found to be correct. The learned State counsel submits that the petitioner was earlier released on parole, however, he misused the order of parole and subsequently was arrested.

Keeping in view the antecedents of the petitioner, no case for releasing the petitioner on parole is made out.
