Prayer made in the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing the detainee, namely, Ajay Pal Singh, who is the son of the present petitioner, from the illegal custody of respondents No. 3 and 4. Further a prayer has also been made to appoint a Warrant Officer to search the alleged detainee.

Learned counsel for the State has filed the status reports on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2, by way of affidavit of Satnam Singh, PPS, Superintendent of Police (Inv.) Khanna, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, Punjab and on behalf of respondent No.3, by way of affidavit of Baljinder Singh, Inspector, Incharge CIA Staff Khanna, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana. The same are taken on record.

On the basis of the said replies, learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner is neither required in any case nor he is in the

illegal custody of the police.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
