On 23.09.2016 the following order was passed :-

“This is a petition praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondents to get release or produce the detenue Raghbir Singh son of Sukhdev Singh who is alleged to be in the illegal custody of respondents No.5 & 6.

The averments in the writ petition are duly supported by an affidavit.

Notice of motion only to respondent No.1 at this stage. Learned counsel undertakes to serve the respondent No.1 by way of dasti process. May do so. Dasti only.

Keeping in view the averments made in the petition which are duly supported by the affidavit of the petitioner, a roving writ in the nature of habeas corpus is issued and a

Warrant Officer is appointed, to be nominated by the Registry, to conduct the search at premises of respondents No. 5 & 6 or any other place to be pointed out by the petitioner. Fee of the Warrant Officer shall be borne by the petitioner.

The Warrant Officer shall submit his report to this Court on or before the next date.

To come up on 07.10.2016.”

As per the report of the Warrant Officer the detinue has been got released.

In the circumstances, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
