FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Mr. Amarjit son of Sardar Masih, resident of Village Pahra, who has been identified by Inspector Rajinder Singh, Station House Officer, Police Station Tibber has made statement before this Court that he undertakes to take away the girl Rekha, who is in relationship with his son Bikram, the latter having been lodged in the custody as on date and has further made statement that he would undertake to maintain and upkeep the girl as well as her security and would be responsible for any consequences.

The girl has acceded to this and has also made statement separately that she is willing to accompany Amarjit, whose family has shown their willingness to take her in their fold.

Since the girl is major she is at liberty to live her own life as per her sweet will. Rajinder Singh SHO, who is present in the Court along with lady constable Amrik Kaur is directed to ensure that girl is

escorted to the house where she wants to go and ensure her safety during her transit. However, directions are issued to the Police to ensure due safety of the life and personal liberty of the girl and in case any instance is brought to their notice they shall take immediate action as per law. Station House Officer, Rajinder Singh is also submitted before this Court that since the girl is major no action is required to be taken on the complaint of the father of the girl.

Since nothing survives in the present petition the same as such stands disposed off.
