Instant application dated 13.09.2016 was sent by petitioner-Raghbir alleging that the police party visited his house on earlier occasions also. On 12.09.2016, at bout 8.00 P.M., some police officials came to his house, gave beatings and threatened him and his family members. It is also alleged that the police officials took away his son-Vikas, vehicle and key of another vehicle. It is prayed that his son-Vikas may be got released from the illegal custody and life and liberty of his family members may be protected.

This application was taken up on judicial side.

Notice of motion was issued and learned State counsel was directed to produce the report before this Court after getting the matter inquired through senior police officer.

Today, learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit

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of Sh. Tahir Hussain, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rohtak, in the Court. Same is taken on record.

I have heard learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per reply, three cases (two cases for committing murder and one case for committing attempt to murder), are already pending against Vikas @ Vicky. It is also mentioned in reply that Vikas was also arrested in FIR No.514 dated 13.09.2016, registered under Sections 398 and 401 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar Rohtak and his mother was informed telephonically about his arrest. On 14.09.2016, in pursuance of disclosure statement of accused-Vikas, illegal weapons were recovered. List of cases registered against Kulbir and Parveen @ Sonu, co-accused of Vikas @ Vicky, have also been given in the said reply.

Keeping in view the fact that Vikas @ Vicky was arrested by the police in FIR No.514 dated 13.09.2016, registered under Sections 398 and 401 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar Rohtak, as mentioned in reply, no further action is required in this petition.
