Through instant Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought emergency parole for a period of two months on account of marriage of his real sister, which is due to be held on 08.11.2016.

2. Notice of motion.

3. At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to proceed with the instant petition and intends to withdraw the same but a liberty be granted to the petitioner to move a fresh application to respondent No.2 for emergency parole on account of marriage of his real sister.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to move an appropriate application to respondent No.2-Superintendent, District Jail, Yamuna Nagar within a period of 7 days and on receipt of the said application, the same shall be dealt with and finally disposed of by respondent No.2, within a period of two weeks.
