Reply by way of affidavit of Ashok Kumar, Deputy Superintendent, Prison at present acting Superintendent of Prison, District Prison, Karnal, has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 in Court today, which is taken on record. Copy has been supplied.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner prays for his temporary release on parole in terms of Section 3(1) (b) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for a period of two weeks to enable him to attend the marriage of his sister fixed for 11.10.2016 at Village Bhallan, Police Station Rajaund, Distt. Kaithal.

The petitioner has been convicted by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal for the offence punishable under Section 506 IPC and 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012. He has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 12 years, besides, pay a fine of Rs.12,000/-. The petitioner has been lodged in Karnal

District Jail.

As per the reply filed, the petitioner has undergone sentence of 1 year, 7 months and 20 days. It is submitted that the parole case of the petitioner was rejected by the Superintendent of Prison, District Prison, Karnal, vide order dated October 3, 2016 (Annex P-4).

In the circumstances, order dated October 3, 2016 (Annex P-4) is set aside and quashed and the petitioner shall be granted two weeks parole, subject to his furnishing bail bond and surety to the satisfaction of District Magistrate, Karnal. The Superintendent of Prison concerned shall inform the petitioner-convict the date when he has to surrender at jail gate.

Petition stands disposed of.
