Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus to secure the release of detenue, namely, Manjeet Kaur-wife of the petitioner.

Vide order dated 10.10.2016 passed by this Court, a Warrant Officer was appointed to visit the spot as suggested by the petitioner and to submit a report.

Accordingly, the Warrant Officer submitted his report dated 15.10.2016 wherein it has been reported that before he was about to leave Chandigarh, he was informed by the petitioner telephonically that at this stage, there is some possibility of amicable settlement of the matter regarding marriage and, therefore, he was not allowed to proceed further in the matter.

In view of report submitted by the Warrant Officer, no further orders are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
