**JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Article 226 read with Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought emergency parole.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though the petitioner applied for emergency parole on the ground that his marriage is to be solemnized on 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2016 to the Superintendent Jail, Sangrur but that was declined vide order dated 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2016. It was only thereafter, the instant petition has been filed.

Though, as per the contents of the above referred order, the petitioner is not entitled for parole as per the prevalent rules but since his marriage is to be solemnized, it would not be desirable to decline the relief claimed.

Since the marriage of the petitioner is fixed for 26<sup>th</sup> October, 2016, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on emergency parole from the date of his release till 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2016 at

the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate, with direction to surrender before the Superintendent Jail on 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2016 at 05:00 pm.
