In letter addressed to Hon'ble the Chief Justice, Sulakhan Singh has expressed an apprehension of arrest as Gurdeep Singh and Dharam Pal have allegedly been taken to police station.

Since the petitioner has already availed the legal remedy, cognizance cannot be taken on the basis of the apprehension mentioned in the letter.
