Convict Surat Mehta moves this petition praying for an emergency parole for six weeks on the ground that his wife was seriously ill and the doctor has advised her to undergo surgery.

The petitioner contended that he moved a petition before the Jail Authorities but the Jail Authorities declined to entertain the petition on the ground that the petitioner had not completed one year of sentence from the date of conviction.

Learned counsel for the State referring to reply filed today by respondents No.1 to 4 submitted that no representation was given by the writ petitioner. It is submitted that the respondent-State will consider such a prayer if at all the convict prefers to submit a representation before the Authorities, in this regard.

In view of the above, directing the writ petitioner to submit a proper representation before the Jail Authorities who shall dispose of the

representation within 21 days from the date of receipt of such representation, the writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
