Prayer made by the petitioner by filing the present writ petition under Sections 3, 4 & 6 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C is for granting parole to him for six weeks in order to carry out agriculture operations and also for enabling him to get his father operated upon.

According to the petitioner, he was convicted vide judgment and order dated 25.01.2013 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar and sentenced to undergo imprisonment for life and against his conviction and sentence he has filed CRA-D-414-DB-2003 which stands admitted for final hearing. Further, his father has moved an application for releasing him on parole for agriculture purpose for six weeks as the crop was on the verge of harvesting and there is none in the house who could harvest the crop. It is also the case of the petitioner that his father is more than 72 years of age and suffering from eye

disease (Cataract) for which he has to be operated upon. The application (Annexure P-1) submitted by the father of the petitioner for his release on parole for the aforementioned purposes has not been considered by the concerned authorities so far.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-1) dated 15.10.2016 already submitted by the father of the petitioner, expeditiously, preferably within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
