Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

Today both the parties as well as minor son of the parties Abyukt Manat Singh Chopra alias Braven is present. On behalf of the petitioner, it has been pressed that she be allowed to meet her son once in a month for limited period so that she can have interaction with her son.

After hearing the parties the time and place for meeting of mother and son, it is ordered as under:-

1. The petitioner shall be allowed to meet her son Abyukt Manat Singh Chopra alias Braven on the last Saturday of every month at McDonald's, Connaught Place, Inner Circle, New Delhi. The son shall be brought by his

father – respondent No.4 to the said place.

2. The duration of meeting shall be between 12.00 Noon to 4.00 PM. Both the parties are directed to behave in orderly manner during the said meeting.
3. Respondent No.4 shall also provide his phone number to the petitioner and will answer the calls of the petitioner.
4. In case of the exams of Abyukt Manat Singh Chopra alias Braven minor or his other sports engagements, respondent No.4 shall inform the petitioner and the date of meeting can be changed with mutual consent.
5. If any of the parties requires any alteration in any of the conditions due to any difficulty arising later on, they can always move this Court.
6. The petitioner, if so desire, can also move this Court later on for longer/ more frequent meetings/ custody or can pray for allowing the child to stay with her.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
