The instant petition has been preferred under Article 266 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus, directing respondent Nos.2 to 4 to produce and bring Sh.Raj Ravinder Trivedi alias Armaan before this Court and/or to release the detainee from the illegal custody of respondent No.4.

In compliance of order dated 27.10.2016, report of the Warrant Officer has been received.

As per the said report, the detainee was not found in Police Station.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that actually when the police came to know that Warrant Officer had arrived they secreted the detainee out of the police station.

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Be that as it may, the instant petition is liable to be dismissed and is so ordered. However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail whatever remedy he wants in respect of the allegations.
