Convict-Darshan Singh has filed the present petition praying for grant of parole for six weeks under Section 3(1)(c) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988.

On our asking, Mr. Ashok Muthreja, DAG, Haryana took notice for the respondents.

On going through the averments in the writ petition, we find that the convict has specifically alleged that the Jail Authorities refused to entertain the application for parole submitted by the petitioner.

Without going into the truth or otherwise of such an averment made in the petition, in the interest of justice, we dispose of the writ petition giving liberty to the petitioner/convict to submit a fresh representation before the respondent/authorities, who shall dispose of the same within 21 days from the date of receipt of such representation.
