Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constituion of India is for grant of extension in parole to the petitioner for 3 months w.e.f. 16.11.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner state that the petitioner was convicted under Section 15 of NDPS Act and his appeal i.e. CRA-S-1445-SB-2007 is pending before this Court and as on date, he is on parole w.e.f. 04.10.2016 to 16.11.2016-the date on which he is required to be surrendered. She states that during parole period, he had arranged finances and material to replace the roof of his badly damaged house. Since the construction of house could not be completed within the parole period, he had submitted an application along with panchayatnama and photograph of house to the jail authorities for extension of parole. She further states that petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 02.11.2016 to respondent No.2- Superintendent, District Jail, Barnala, but no decision has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

It is not disputed that the petitioner was released on parole on 04.10.2016 and is required to surrender on 16.11.2016 before jail authorities. He had submitted a representation dated 02.11.2016 to respondent No.2 for extension of his parole for construction of roof of his badly damaged house.

Without commenting on the claim of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on petitioner's representation dated 02.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) within 1 week from today in accordance with law.
