Learned State counsel has filed additional affidavit of Rajiv Deswal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Gohana, District Sonapat with supporting documents to the fact that wife of the petitioner namely Manisha has already delivered a girl child on midnight of 12th December, 2016 and there is no imminent concern for care of the child.
