Writ petitioner-Ram Rattan who was convicted in a case of murder moves the writ petition praying for grant of emergency parole to attend the last rites of his son and brother-in-law, who died in an accident.

We directed the learned State counsel to get instructions as regards the factum of death of the son and brother-in-law of the writ petitioner in an accident.

Learned State counsel produced the verification report submitted by the concerned Police Station to the effect that the son and brother-in-law of the writ petitioner had died in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 11.11.2016. It is also informed to us based on the above verification report submitted by the concerned Police Station that the Bhog ceremony is to be held on 29.11.2016.

Learned counsel for the writ petitioner vehemently submitted that the writ petitioner is entitled to emergency parole to attend the last rites ceremony of the deceased being his son and brother-in-law.

Considering the emergency that has been demonstrated by the writ petitioner, we are pleased to grant 3 days' emergency parole to the writ petitioner to attend the last rites of his son and brother-in-law that is organised on 29.11.2016.

Accordingly, the respondent-Authorities are directed to release the writ petitioner forthwith on execution of sufficient surety bond to the satisfaction of District Magistrate concerned. Writ petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Authorities immediately on expiry of 3 days from the date when he is released by the Authorities on emergency parole.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
