On the basis of representation made by the petitioner that her husband-Angrej Singh has been taken into custody by the police, present case was numbered.

Learned State counsel has filed reply on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3, 5 and 6 by way of affidavit of Mukhtiar Singh, PPS, Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur. The same is taken on record.

As per the reply, a case bearing FIR No.122 dated 09.10.2016 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Ferozepur Cantt against one Chamkaur Singh son of Avtar Singh resident of Phase-2 Bedi Colony Ferozpur City, was registered. During interrogation, said Chamkaur Singh had disclosed that he used to purchase the heroin from Angrej Singh @ Geja son of Baldev Singh (alleged detainee) resident of Bandala and sell the same to other persons in retail. Thus, the son of the

petitioner, namely, Angrej Singh @ Geja (alleged detenue) has been named as an accused in the said FIR.

At this stage, Mr.Karanjeet Singh Brar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 7 to 12 and filed Power of Attorneys on their behalf. The same are taken on record.

Since the husband of the petitioner Angrej Singh @ Geja (alleged detenue) has been named as an accused in the said FIR, the prayer of the petitioner cannot be accepted. Accordingly, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
