Learned counsel for the State has filed affidavit of Sh. Amit Kumar, Superintendent of Jail, District Prison, Sirsa. The same is taken on record.

The petitioner seeks four weeks' emergency parole to enable him to look after his ailing wife who, it is stated, is having severe pain in her abdomen due to stones and the Doctor had advised urgent operation.

In terms of the reply that has been filed, it is stated that the health of petitioner's wife namely Sunita was got verified through SHO, Police Station, City Sirsa. According to the verification report submitted by the Medical Officer, Civil Hospital, Sirsa it has, inter alia been, stated that no emergency surgery was required in such a case, however, elective surgery after four weeks could be carried out on

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patient on consent of her relatives. It is further stated that the patient was stable and was given antibiotics and analgesis.

In the circumstances, no ground for grant of emergency parole is made out. The petitioner may, however, apply for parole in accordance with the provisions of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988.

The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
