S.S. SARON, J.

The petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 for extending the parole that has been granted to the petitioner vide Annexure P-1 for further period of six weeks.

The petitioner is undergoing life imprisonment after his conviction by the learned Sessions Judge, Sangrur on 19.08.2014 in case FIR No. 234 dated 24.09.2013 registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 201, 148/149 Indian Penal Code. He has filed CRA-D-1388-DB of 2014, which is pending in this Court. The appeal was admitted on 04.09.2014.

The petitioner while undergoing his imprisonment
was released on parole for a period of 42 days commencing from

19.10.2016 till 01.12.2016. The petitioner seeks extension of parole on the ground that his wife namely Amarjeet Kaur is suffering from 'Ca Cervix' cancer and is seriously ill. She is undergoing treatment at Homi Bhabha Cancer Hospital of Tata Memorial Centre, Sangrur.

During the course of hearing, we have pointed out to learned counsel for the petitioner that in the Plan Summary, which is part of Annexure P-2, the date of Protocol has been mentioned as February 01, 2013. Therefore, it appears that the treatment of the wife of the petitioner has been going on for considerable time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this is probably a typographical mistake. In the circumstances, she prays that she may be allowed to withdraw the petition and file a fresh one after verifying the date.

Criminal writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
