Petitioner Kewal Singh, who is a convict, undergoing sentence in connection with conviction recorded under NDPS Act moves this petition praying for grant of emergency parole for four weeks to celebrate his daughter's marriage celebrated on 08.12.2016.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner brought to our notice Annexure P1, a petition dated 22.11.2016 already submitted before the Superintendent Central Jail, Fatehpur, District Amritsar, seeking the very same relief. He also submitted that the said petition was not disposed of, inspite of the fact that the marriage of his daughter is solemnised on 08.12.2016.

On our asking, Mr. R.S.Randhawa, Addl.A.G., Punjab, took notice on behalf of the respondents. The paper book was also circulated to him by learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as directed by us.

Petitioner has sought for emergency parole in order to participate in the marriage celebration of his daughter which is proposed to be held on 08.12.2016. Inasmuch as the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is solemnised in a shortwhile, the respondents are directed to dispose of the petition Annexure P1 already submitted on 22.11.2016 by the petitioner seeking emergency parole to attend the marriage of his daughter in accordance with law within two days from today.
