The petitioners who were serving as Binders in the Department of Printing and Stationery, Government of Haryana as Binders, have approached this Court seeking parity with regard to their pay-scales as being given to their juniors namely Sakti Chand, Hazari Lal and Tarsem Lal.

Today, learned counsel appearing on behalf of State of Haryana has produced office orders dated 08.07.2015, 02.11.2015 and 01.06.2015, through which the benefit of higher pay being given to the aforementioned Sakti Chand, Hazari Lal and Tarsem Lal respectively has been withdrawn. It is further submitted that after the withdrawal of the benefit of access pay, their pay has been refixed and as on date, the petitioners being seniors are drawing higher pay than the aforementioned three persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the aforementioned statement, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
