Affidavit of Sh. Gurmeet Singh Chauhan, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala, who is also a Member of Special Investigation Team constituted for arresting the accused in FIR No.142 dated 27.11.2016 under Sections 307, 392, 223, 224, 120-B, 148, 149, IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 Arms Act registered at Police Station Kotwali, Nabha in which 15 named persons and 15 unknown persons are wanted, has been filed by learned State counsel.

It is mentioned in Para No.4 of the affidavit that neither the grand son of the petitioner namely Gurpreet Singh Sekhon has been arrested nor has been detained or is in custody of the police authorities, rather, he is still absconding. Particulars of 20 criminal cases in addition to the present case have been mentioned in Para No.4 in which Gurpreet Singh Sekhon is already facing trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP Manpreet Singh, submits that as soon as Gurpreet Singh Sekhon is arrested, he will be produced before the Area Magistrate.

In view of the affidavit and the submissions made by learned State counsel, no further action in the present case is required to be taken and the petition is accordingly disposed of.
