Rule. Heard forthwith learned counsel for the rival parties.

This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking parole, by the petitioner-convict, whose appeal in a murder case has also been dismissed by the Court as fairly stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Avtar Singh, state that the marriage of the niece of the petitioner and particularly, important functions will be held on 18.12.2016 at Jalandhar.

The submission that the petitioner should be released on parole for more than a day, is not acceptable since the appeal filed by him has been dismissed by this Court in 2013. However, the petitioner can be allowed to attend the marriage of his niece on 18.12.2016 in morning, in police custody and shall be lodged back in the Jail in the

evening on the same day before 5 o'clock.

In that view of the matter, the respondent-State is directed to take the petitioner to attend the marriage ceremony of his niece under the police custody in morning on 18.12.2016 and cause his entry in Jail again on the same day in the evening before 5 o'clock.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
