1. The criminal writ petition preferred by Mohinder Singh has sought for grant of parole under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 (1) (d) of Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 (for short, 'Act'), to enable him to attend marriage of his grand-daughter (daughter of daughter).

2. The factum of the marriage has not been disputed by the State. Rather, the State has verified the facts and visited the house of the petitioner and found that marriage of Amandeep Kaur D/o Paramjeet Kaur is fixed for February 07, 2016 at Har-Raj Resorts, Chadik Road, Moga.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has put reliance on the Division Bench order of this Court passed in **Criminal Writ Petition No. 1621 of 2014** captioned **'Gurwinder Singh versus State of Punjab and others'** decided on November 05, 2014 wherein, petitioner was granted the parole enabling him to attend and participate in the marriage of his cousin sister, whereas in the case in hand, the marriage of grand-daughter of the petitioner is going to be solemnized on February 7, 2016.

4. Taking into consideration the afore-said aspects, instant petition is disposed of and petitioner is granted 5 days parole from the date of his release subject to his furnishing personal bond and surety to the satisfaction of concerned District Magistrate. He shall surrender back in jail after the expiry of 5 days.
