On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed:

This petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the official respondents to release the detenues as mentioned in para No.5 from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the prayer for appointment of a Warrant Officer but prays for issuance of a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Distict Moga - respondent No.2 for holding an enquiry into the allegations made in this petition.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on

behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply a copy of the petition to the learned D.A.G. during the course of the day.

The respondent No.2 is directed to enquire into the averments made in the present petition and submit a report to this Court. He/she shall also exercise powers vested in him/her under the Bonded Labour System(Abolition) Act, 1976.

Adjourned to 19.12.2016.

A copy of this order be given to the learned Deputy Advocate General under the signatures of the Bench Secretary for onward transmission and compliance to the Deputy Commissioner, District Moga.

Report of respondent No.2 has been received stating that raid was made and the petitioner and his wife Rakhi were found to be working there and they were got released and remaining persons were not found.

In these circumstances, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.
