This petition is filed by the petitioner under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988, seeking extension of emergency parole.

Rule heard forthwith.

Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

This court vide order dated 08.11.2016 has granted four weeks' parole for the reasons stated therein.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited my attention towards the certificate issued from the same hospital that the implants of his daughter is to be removed, therefore, he prays for further extension of parole.

Looking to the nature of the relief claimed by the petitioner, I think, the parole should be extended by two weeks by way of last chance. No further application for extension of parole will be entertained.

Hence, the rule is made absolute. The period of parole is extended for further two weeks which will start from 15.12.2016. The petitioner shall surrender on completion of parole of another two weeks.
