Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 CrPC is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents for grant of pre-mature release of the petitioner from District Prison, Gurgaon as he has already undergone more than 14 years of actual sentence.

Learned State counsel seeks time to file reply.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to consider and decide the representation dated 27.11.2015 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner before respondent no.4.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 27.11.2015 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law, within two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order .
