Petitioner seeks issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 for grant of emergency parole to him.

It comes out that the petitioner has not moved any application before the Jail Superintendent.

In these circumstances, liberty is given to the petitioner to approach the concerned Jail Superintendent for grant of emergency parole. If any application is filed, the Jail Superintendent shall dispose of the same expeditiously, in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
