Learned counsel for the State has filed affidavit of Shri Hardeep Singh Bhatti, PPS, Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. The same is taken on record.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner Jatinder Singh @ Goldi is undergoing life imprisonment after his conviction by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur on 11.08.2015 in case FIR No.391 dated 14.11.2011 registered at Police Station, City Sangrur for the offences under Sections 302, 341, 148 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC'-for short).

By way of the present petition, he seeks extension of parole for four weeks from 10.02.2016 as his father Balwinder Singh is suffering from stomach pain and stone in Gallbladder

and the doctor advised immediate surgery.

Notice of motion was issued on 09.02.2016 for today and the parole granted to the petitioner which was to expire on 10.02.2016 was extended till today.

In terms of the reply that has been filed in Court today, it is stated that the petitioner was granted six weeks parole on 30.12.2015 and he was to surrender back in jail on 11.02.2016. The medical status of the father of the petitioner has been verified through the Incharge Police Station Sadar Dhuri/Incharge Police Chowki Bhalwan. As per the report of the Police Chowki Bhalwan, the father of the petitioner has been operated on 11.02.2016 for Cholelithiasis with cholecystitis and he is admitted in the hospital. The mother of the petitioner has expired and the petitioner is looking after his father.

In view of the said position, on request of learned counsel for the petitioner, the parole granted to the petitioner is extended by another ten days. The petitioner shall surrender back in jail on 26.02.2016 at the prescribed time.

The bail bonds and surety furnished by him shall remain in force and operative till he surrenders back in jail.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
