INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of Habeas Corpus, especially in the nature of roving writ by appoint Warrant Officer to visit the house of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and to get released detainee Meenakshi Nanda, wife of the petitioner, from the custody of said respondents.

Notice of motion was issued.

Today, detainee Meenakshi Nanda, who is present in person before this Court, states that she is residing with her parents at her own wish and she has not been illegally detained by anybody. She also states that she is the wife of Hemant Nanda-petitioner, against whom she has already filed a divorce petition.

In view of the statement of detainee Meenakshi Nanda, no further action is required in this petition.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
