Heard the submissions made by learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner as well as learned Additional AG, Haryana.

The writ petitioner Sanjay @ Sanjeet who is a convict serving sentence in connection with FIR No.768 dated 23.11.2000 registered under Sections 302, 216 and 34, IPC, Police Station City Rohtak and FIR No.256 dated 26.10.2008 registered under Sections 302, 148 and 120-B, IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act, Police Station Sadar, Gohana, District Sonapat challenges the order passed by the Superintendent of Jail, District Jail, Yamuna Nagar declining the furlough for three weeks prayed for by him.

We carefully went through the impugned order passed by the 3rd respondent.

The 3rd respondent has rightly declined the furlough sought for by the writ petitioner on the ground that the writ petitioner was convicted in two cases under Section 302 of IPC. In our considered view, 3rd respondent has properly classified the writ petitioner as a 'Hardcore Criminal' inasmuch as he was convicted in two different murder cases.

Therefore, we find that there is no merit in the writ petition.

The writ petition stands dismissed.
