Reply on behalf of the State has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

It comes out that one Sandeep Gandoli was killed in police firing in Mumbai when Police party went from Gurgaon to Mumbai. Therefore, primarily the alleged crime has been committed in Mumbai which is beyond the jurisdiction of this Court. Secondly, it comes out that now the High Court of Bombay is seized the matter and has directed to register the case. However, on the plea of Gurgaon Police, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has stayed the said order. In this way, Bombay High Court as well as the Hon'ble Apex Court are seized the matter. Therefore, no action in this complaint received through e-mail is called for.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail appropriate remedy before the Mumbai Court, where the crime is stated to have been committed.

The present petition stands disposed of.
