She has stated that she was beaten up by her husband – petitioner and he left her in the house of Jaspal Kaur. Now she will go to the house of the petitioner after 22.2.2016 when the matter is settled by the Panchayat.

Therefore, it comes out that it is not a case of illegal detention.

Hence, the present habeas corpus petition stands dismissed.
