JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a criminal writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for grant of parole to petitioner- Navdeep Singh @ Bakshi for a period of one month on account of the marriage of his sister.

2. Notice of motion.
3. At the asking of Court, Mr. A.S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though at the time of institution of present petition, no application/representation was

moved to the concerned authorities but yesterday a representation/ application has been moved to the Superintendent Central Jail, Amritsar and it appears that the Superintendent Central Jail, Amritsar is seized of the matter.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the instant petition be disposed of with the direction to the aforesaid authorities to deal with and dispose of the matter.

6. The instant petition is disposed of with the directions to the Superintendent Central Jail, Amritsar to consider the representation/ application moved yesterday on behalf of the petitioner and to dispose of the same by 25.02.2016.
