In pursuant to the directions of this Court, detenue Gagandeep Kaur has been produced in the Court today by Lady Constable Luxmi Devi, Police Station Tapa, Tehsil and District Barnala.

On the request of the petitioner, he was allowed to meet the detenue for five minutes. The statement of detenue has been recorded, in which she has stated that she was voluntary living with her parents and now she wants to accompany her husband Partap Singh (petitioner).

In view of the matter, detenue Gagan Deep Kaur is allowed to accompany the petitioner. The S.H.O., P.S. Tapa, Tehsil and District Barnala is directed to provide necessary protection to the

life and liberty of the petitioner to ensure that the private respondents do not interfere in their married life.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
