The petition has been filed seeking temporary release of the petitioner for four weeks so as to enable him to see his mother who is stated to be ailing.

The petitioner has admittedly not approached the jail authorities for grant of emergency parole in terms of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962.

Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition at this stage and in the first instance, approach the jail authorities.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

In case the petitioner approaches the jail authorities for grant of temporary release on parole, the same shall be considered by the competent authority in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.
