This is a Criminal Writ Petition filed by convict Pawan Kumar @ Pawandeep Singh @ Pawna praying for grant of emergency parole on medical grounds in view of Section 3 (1) (d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners Temporary Release Act, 1962 for 4 weeks.

Heard the submissions made by either side. The petitioner is undergoing life sentence for having allegedly committed the offence under Sections 302, 307, 326, 325, 323 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged by the writ petitioner that his mother is suffering from Gal Bladder Stone and she has been advised for urgent operation. The writ petitioner being the son wants to be by the side of his mother at the time of operation.

We put up a question during the course of argument whether the writ petitioner submitted any application before the authority concerned seeking parole on the medical grounds. The positive reply by the counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner in fact submitted an application before the authority concerned.

In the above facts and circumstances, Superintendent Central Jail, Bathinda is directed to consider on merits the application, if any, submitted by the writ petitioner seeking emergency parole on the medical ground within 7 days from the date of receipt of the order of this Court.

The order be issued today itself.

Writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
