Petitioner Jasbir Singh @ Bhinda has filed the present petition for grant of emergency parole for a period of 4 weeks so as to enable him to solemnize the marriage of his niece Manpreet Kaur on 20.01.2016.

According to the petitioner, his brother Surinderpal Singh, father of Manpreet Kaur has already expired. Said Manpreet Kaur is getting married on 20.01.2016 with Mannimrat Singh. There is no other person in the house of the petitioner who can solemnize the marriage of his niece. Prayer has, accordingly, been made for granting emergency parole to the petitioner.

Upon notice, learned State counsel has informed the Court that the petitioner was released on parole for a period of 42 days and on the expiry of the said period he had surrendered before the Jail Authorities on 25.12.2015.

Heard. Keeping in view the facts mentioned in the petition, this Court is of the considered view that the presence of the petitioner who is uncle of Manpreet Kaur would be most essential at the time of her marriage as her father has already expired.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on parole for a period of 10 days subject to his furnishing appropriate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate, Amritsar.
