Kurshid wife of late Ajit Masih, resident of Village Hake Wala, District Ferozepur has sent an application to the office of Hon'ble Chief Justice of this Court, which was taken on judicial side.

In the said application, it is stated by the applicant that her son Yakub Masih was arrested by the police on 16.02.2016 at 4:00 p.m. from his house and he is in illegal custody of the police for the last three days.

Notice of motion was issued to the State of Punjab. Learned State counsel was directed to get the matter enquired and produce the report.

Today, reply by way of affidavit of Vibhor Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Ferozepur on behalf of respondent-State has been filed. Same is taken on record.

In the said reply, it is stated that Yakub Masih was arrested by the police on 19.02.2016 in case FIR No.17 dated 19.02.2016 under Sections 420/120 IPC. Now, he is in the judicial custody and the allegations stated in the application have been denied.

Further, perusal of the record shows that the application sent by the

applicant-petitioner on 19.02.2016 was received by the office of Hon'ble Chief Justice on 25.02.2016.

In view of the fact that Yakub Masih has been arrested in the aforesaid FIR and now he is in the judicial custody, therefore, no further action is required in this case. Accordingly, the instant petition stands disposed of. However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the remedy as available to her, as per law.
