The State has filed the reply. Respondents No. 4 and 5 have also put in appearance.

It comes out that the dispute is regarding custody of minor son Surkabh Singh, aged about 3 years. Respondent No. 4 is the husband of the petitioner. Since it is a dispute of custody and the custody of the son by the father cannot be called illegal. Therefore, the proper remedy is to approach the family court for custody of the minor.

It being so, the present petition is disposed of, holding that it is not a case of illegal detention.
