Prayer made in the petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. and Section 3 (1)(c) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988, is for issuance of direction to the respondents to release him on parole for six weeks for agricultural purposes, or, in the alternative, to direct the respondents to decide his application for the aforementioned purpose.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on going through the petition, this Court finds that the petitioner has submitted application dated 6.1.2016 (Annexure P-1) to the authorities for his release on parole for

agricultural purposes. Even his wife has also sent an application dated 16.2.2016 (Annexure P-2) but according to the petitioner, none of the two applications has been decided by the authorities so far.

In view of the same, this Court intends to dispose of the petition by issuing directions to the authorities to decide the application filed by the petitioner and also the application submitted by his wife wherein request has been submitted to release the petitioner on parole.

Resultantly, the petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Superintendent, District Jail, Narnaul to consider and take final decision on the applications (Annexures P-1 and P-2), submitted by the petitioner and his wife respectively, for release of the petitioner on parole, expeditiously, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
